Subject: EBOLA VIRUS DISEASE - UPDATE

Dear colleagues,

Further to Clinical Advisory on EVD issued on August 20th, please find below an update:

1. The Risk Assessment Tool issued on August 20th (version 1.7 19082014)has been revised by Health Protection Surveillance Centre (HPSC). **Version 1.7** is now withdrawn and should not be used. Effective immediately, version 2.0 08092014 is now authorised for use.

The phrase "Ambulance Service VHF Procedures Activated" indicates the following should be done:

- Don PPE as per the risk assessment tool
- Notify Control of the EVD status of the patient
- 2. Countries now affected by EVD are as follows:
 - Guinea
 - Liberia
 - Nigeria
 - Senegal
 - Sierra Leone
 - Democratic Republic of the Congo

The countries affected may change – ambulance practitioners should contact Control as required if assessing a patients travel or contact history.

Control staff should, on a daily basis, review the HPSC website www.hpsc.ie for updates on affected countries.
