SUBJECT: Direct access PPCI to St James's Hospital for STEMI patients. Effective from 1100 hours Monday June 17th , St James's Hospital will resume direct access to the PCI lab for STEMI patients. Procedure for this is unchanged-see Policy NASCG017 Appropriate Hospital Access for STEMI Patients. Clinical Directive 02-2013 will lapse at 1100 Monday June 17th
