CLINICAL DIRECTIVE 05/2015

TO: EMTs, Paramedics, Advanced Paramedics, Call Takers, Call Dispatchers, All Supervisors, All Managers
SUBJECT: Primary PCI St Vincents University Hospital
Effective 1600 hours Friday April 17th , St Vincent's University Hospital will permanently cease the provision of primary PCI for STEMI patients. Going forward, identified STEMI patients should not be transported to SVUH but to the next nearest PPCI centre, St James's Hospital.
RATIONALE: This change is permanent. From April 17 th , there will be two hospitals in Dublin providing primary PCI for STEMI patients – St James's Hospital and Mater Misericordiae University Hospital.
EFFECTIVE FROM: 1600 hours April 17th 2015
EFFECTIVE TO: Indefinite

Clinical Directives apply to all relevant staff in the HSE National Ambulance Service, Dublin Fire Brigade and Irish Coast Guard helicopter winch-crew.
